

Enrico Borgarello



Enrico Borgarello graduated in Chemistry from the University of Torino. From 1980 to 1986 he was Research Associate at the EPFL (Ecole Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne) and at the University of Montreal, and worked on the application of photocatalysis to the production of hydrogen from water and to the degradation of pollutants in water.

During his 19-year career at Eni, he was R&D Manager and was also appointed Senior Scientist.

In December 2006 he received the Sapio Award for Italian Research.

Since 2005 he has been Director of Research & Development and Laboratories at the Italcementi Group Technical Center which, under his leadership, has developed some of the most innovative

applications regarding building materials. In January 2010, Enrico Borgarello was appointed Director of the newly formed Innovation Department.

Enrico Borgarello is member of various professional associations and bodies, among which Unicemento Steering Committee and the “Innovation” Working Group in Federcostruzioni; he is coordinator of the “Concrete” Working Group in UNI; he is member of the Research and Innovation Technical Committee in Confindustria.

In 1981 he received the Lorgna Award, from the Accademia dei Lincei (National Academy of Science) – Rome.

In 1997 he received the Steinkopff Award from the German Chemical Society – Munich.

He has developed 25 patents and has published over 80 articles regarding the field of applied colloid science.
